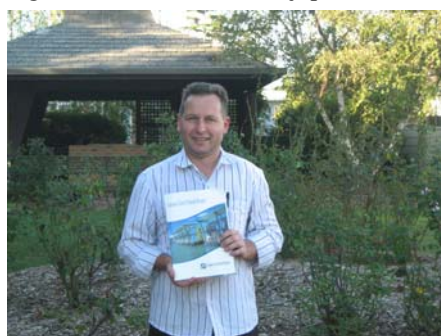
Friends of Music (FOM)

Looking for Host Families

Tintern Schools have been approached by the tour manager who supported the Tintern Schools UK trip in 2007 to see if we would be interested in playing netball and hockey for girls and soccer for boys, against a touring UK school in August. The touring party is from the Burford School which hosted our students on their sports tour of the UK in 2007.

They are keen to know if we would be able to host the touring party for the three nights that they will be in Melbourne. The Burford School community went out of their way to ensure our students were well taken care of when they were in the UK. Indeed, some of the participants may already be known to past and current Tintern Schools' students who were involved in the 2007 tour.
