World-renowned duo concert pianists, Penelope Thwaites and John Lavender, are returning to Tintern Schools to delight the audience by performing some popular classical piano works.

Penelope, a past Tintern student, and John, a past member of the Tintern music staff, have performed together as a duo since 1979 and form a unique piano partnership due to their uncanny fusion of personal styles. They have performed and recorded many programs of Australian music and are pre-eminent in the four-hand works of Percy Grainger. They last performed at the school in 1997.

This musical event is sure to sell out, so book your tickets early to avoid disappointment.
